CFG Finance GmbH does not receive any other payments as remuneration. In the case of insurance contracts that are mediated and/or managed by an underwriting agency of the Ecclesia Group as an insurance agent for insurers, said company receives a commission from the insurer for its activities on behalf of the insurer, which is included in the insurance premium.
